मानवलोक ग्रामीण विकासाच्या उपक्रमात १९८२ पासून पाणलोट, शेती, आरोग्य, शिक्षण, वृद्ध, महिला इ. घटकांच्या विकासासाठी सातत्याने प्रयत्नशील आहे. संस्थेचे संस्थापक सचिव डॉ.द्वारकादासजी लोहिया (बाबुजी) यांच्या स्मृती प्रित्यर्थ दि.०७.०९.२०२१ (जयंती) ते २३.११.२०२१ (पुण्यतिथी) या कालावधीत विविध सामाजिक प्रश्नावर सुरु असलेल्या अनेक नव्या प्रयोगांची माहिती देण्याकरिता व्याख्यानमालेचे आयोजन केले आहे.

## Webinar No- 09

<b>Title</b>	The role of Kisanputra Andolan and today's farmer

On 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 Manavlok's College of Social Work Ambajogai organized the online webinar on the topic of Kisanputra Andolan. The webinar was conducted on the occasion of the Smruti Samaroh of Dr. Dwarkadasji Lohiya (Babuji). Shri. Amar Habib was the resource person, he is re-known social worker and journalist. Kisanputra Andolan is run under his leadership. Marathwada region is continuously facing drought and farmer's suicide problem. So it is important to understand the views of farmer's leader and their expectations from government on this burning issue.

According to the Dr. Swaminathan Commission, the price of agricultural produce should be guaranteed at one and a half times the cost of production, government procurement centers should be started, and loan waivers should be given to farmers. It should be removed, crop damage to wild animals should be included in the criteria of the insurance scheme, iron wire fence should be provided to the farm at government expense, and compensation of 75 thousand rupees per hectare was given.

Not only the system but also the laws are against the farmers. Kisanputra will file a petition against these laws in the Supreme Court. Farmers go on hunger strike, bitten by sticks and politicians are busy only with contest elections and come to power. They say what will happen with a one-day fast. So it is also a fact that the government did not wake up even after a yearlong hunger strike. Sarkar's skin is not that of a rhinoceros but that of marble. Farmer leader Amar Habib criticized that how can we expect the government to wake up.


Farmers and women are the initiators of wealth creation, so their independence is important. Open system came in industrial sector and elsewhere but it should come in agriculture. Three major anti-farmer laws are the biggest obstacles to its non-come. So Kisanputra Andolan, repeal Maximum Agricultural Land Retention Act. Repeal of the

Essential Commodities Act and repeal of the Land Acquisition Act has been continuously raising these three demands. In fact, the agitation is going on based on these three demands.

To prevent these 3 laws from being challenged, the laws have been placed in scheduled 9 (the laws in this appendix cannot be challenged in court) Entrepreneurs can buy any amount of land in this country. But farmers cannot keep more than 54 acres of arable land or 18 acres of horticultural land. Therefore, big businessmen do not invest in agriculture and agriculture does not develop as an industry and the agriculture falls into pieces and the farmer stands at the door of suicide. The Essential Commodities Act allows the government to intervene in the market of agricultural commodities. The government pays for it. Onion, pulses, sugarcane have been seen many times in this regard. Due to this, license permit quota raj has started and corruption has increased. Rural industrialization was limited. Politicians and officials earn money by taking away the land of farmers and giving it to industrialists under the Land Acquisition Act. Farmers demand that these three laws should be repealed as the government does not want the right to acquire land as this is a system that makes the capitalists landless and unemployed.
