
2) Admission:

3) Result of the College:

4) Student-teacher-parent-management meet:

Student-teacher-parent-management meet is organized every year in the college, after completion of M.S.W admission process. Newly admitted students and parents are given information about the rules of the university, discipline in the college, attendance in field work, report writing, revision etc. As a result, college attendance remains above 90 percent. In the academic year 2020-2021, the Student, Parents, Teachers, Management Meeting was canceled due to covid19.

5) Library:

The college has 5883 syllabus related and reference books, stories books, novels, literature, encyclopedias related to social work subjects. In addition, there are 15 magazines of various publications and national, state, divisional, district and local level newspapers. The library has a separate reading room for students and professors. In addition, an e-library has been set up in the library. The N-List Inflibnet, OPAC facility is available in the library to make e-book resources available to students and professors. In addition, the library has four computer sets for the convenience of students. The head of the library and his colleagues strive to make the library more useful and important.

On the occasion of Dr. Dwarkadas Lohia (Babuji) Memorial Day, a lecture series was organized on behalf of Manavlok and Manavlok's Colege of Social Work. Online webinar was organized on behalf of the library for the readers, professors, research students, etc., to get acquainted with e-books, e-journals, etc., e-resources literature tools and to get in the habit of continuous reading during Kovid-19. A webinar on this topic was organized on 22.09.2020 at 11 am. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, Director of Marathwada University, Aurangabad, Dr. Dharmaraj Veer gave in-depth and detailed guidance to all the listeners, students and professors. Through this, students and professors were introduced to many books and the websites where those books are available, as well as information about free online and e-resources. For this webinar, Shri Aniket Lohia, the administrator of Manavlok Sanstha and the principal of the college Dr. Prakash Jadhav and all the teachers, non-teaching staff, students and professors of other colleges, librarians, research students, etc. took advantage of the lecture.

In the academic year 2020-2022 Purchase of new books in the library 44, 05 books presented by Dr. Rama Pande, 02 book presented by Dr. Arundhati Patil.

6. Fieldwork:

Fieldwork is an integral part of social work. Students studying social work need to be introduced to different social work organizations. Such introductions should motivate the students to do social work, create empathy for the neglected, deprived, blind, disabled, mentally handicapped, elderly, chronically ill, victims, etc. Fieldwork includes Orientation visits and regular visits.

A) Orientation Visits -

Orientation Visits are made to study the various organizations working in the field of social work, their working system, the services rendered, the nature of the services and the overall administration. The following institutes were visited during the academic year 2020-2021 for the students to get acquainted with these institutes. On July 15, Orientation visit workshops was conducted for first year students. Students were guided by Sheikh Nazir. Orientation Visits were given to Manavlok Ambajogai, Manaswini Mahila Project Ambajogai, Jeevan Aadhar Project Girvali, ICTC Center Swami Ramanand Tirtha Medical College and Hospital Ambajogai, Rural Police Station Ambajogai.

B) Fieldwork -

In field work the Knowledge of social work is demonstrated in the community and in various institutions. Agency base (case work, group work) for first year students and placement in different communities for second year students. In the agency-based field work, the students adopted two methods of social work, Case Work and Group Work. Under this method, students deal with individual problems of a person in the institution. Client selected and work was done to solve the problem of the problem person using the principles, techniques and techniques of casework. Under the group work, form groups of people with similar problems and explain their questions through the group. Group work was done using the principles, techniques and skills of group work. The second year students have gone to different communities and demonstrated the third method of social work in community organization. Under this approach, he worked with the community at the community level to understand the community, identify community issues and solve them. At the same time, the students carried out field work projects, community based research on various issues in the community. In this two year course, students try to study all the six methods of social work. Students also participated in activities like Morcha, statements to various government departments, Baitha Satyagraha.

Fieldwork Workshop:

A field work workshop was conducted on 25th August 2020 on behalf of the college through zoom meeting. In this workshop, Dr. Arundhati Patil, Dr. Rama Pandey, Dr. Prakash Jadhav, Dr. Sheikh Nazir, Prof. Kisan Shingare, Dr. Hanumantha Salunke guide students on various activities of field work.

7. Rural Camp:

Manavlok's College of Social Work, Ambajogai organized rural camp for the MSW II semester students. It is a compulsory 5 days activity given in the syllabus. This camp provides opportunities to students about experiences of rural life analyze rural dynamics and observe the local self-government and voluntary organizations. It also helps to develop skills, study the government schemes and report their experiences. It is expected that the camp should be organized at village level where all students can get learning experience. But, in the year 2020 the area is facing COVID 19 pandemic situation. To control this situation the central and state Government, UGC and university has declared protective norms. College has followed these norms strictly and organized rural camp at the native places of students with the regular online supervision by coordinator and co coordinators.

The camp focused on providing the exposure of socio-economic development through various government schemes in rural area. One day workshop was conducted for students to aware government schemes which implemented for rural poor. In this workshop students followed the rules and regulations of the college. Students were given guidance about how to communicate beneficiaries collect information and prepare the report. The list of villages prepared and students placed in respective villages. The permission of rural camp letters given to concerned Grampanchayats. The Rural camp was held from 3rd August to 07th August 2021. 40 students (female 19 and male 21) were participated in this camp.

THEAM: "IMPACT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES ON RURAL POOR"

According to syllabus a theme was developed by Camp Coordinator and the responsibility among students was distributed. Due to COVID 19 pandemic situation, the organizer decided above theme that will enrich the learning experience with care and safety of the students. Social policies of the government are aimed to social welfare. Out of these policies number of schemes takes place to establish social justice and social change. The attempt through this rural camp is made to explore the knowledge of students about such schemes and its impact on rural poor.

OBJECTIVES OF THE RURAL CAMP:

To make students understand about:

- To experiences in rural life
- > To analyze dynamics in rural development
- > To study the impact of rural development schemes on rural poor.
- To develop various skills and intervention strategies of social work methods.

STRATEGY:

As per the academic calendar, rural camp was planned in the month of July, butconsidering COVID19 pandemic situation, with the permission of Principal, it was decided to organize itin the first week of the August 2021.

- ❖ The dates were decided and notice displayed on the student's whatsapp group before 7 days.
- ❖ The format of report writing was developed and provided through online to students.
- ❖ The list of students placed in 40 concern villages was provided.
- Permission letter to Grampanchayat was provided.
- ❖ To aware various government schemes and intervention with beneficiaries, follow the rules in COVID19, one day workshop was conducted online on 2nd August 2021.
- During the camp duration the Supervisory visits by coordinator and cocoordinators.
- ❖ After completing the rural camp, students should submit their reports on 11th August 2021.

8. Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Education:

The College has been imparting vocational knowledge along with intellectual knowledge to the college students every year since 2003 by the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Education under the Department of Extension Education of the University. 9. Various Committees:

- A) Anti-Ragging Committee The Anti-Ragging Committee has been set up as per the Maharashtra Government Act to ensure that the new entrants do not suffer any mental or physical harm from the above students. Since it is a college that teaches social work, there are no forms of ragging in college. The rites of non-discrimination are practiced in the college on the basis of gender equality, socio-economic inequality. To date, no such complaint has been lodged with the committee. As the chairman of the committee, Dr. Arundhati Patil looks after the work.
- **B)** Internal Complaints Committee As per the bill passed in the Lok Sabha in 2013, a committee has been set up in the college for prevention of sexual harassment against women. Dr. Arundhati Patil works as a coordinator of the committee.
- C) Internal Quality Assurance Cell IQAC has been established in the college for quality enhancement. Efforts are made to enhance the quality of the college by exploring internal and external resources. As the coordinator of this committee, Prof. Dr. Rama Pandey oversees this work. In the academic year 2014-2015, the college was evaluated under NAAC. In order to enhance the internal quality of the college and the students, the committee held 06 meetings from time to time and carried out the instructions and facilities as demanded. Career Mentoring Camps, Competitive Examination Mentoring Camps and Mentoring Camps on Study Related Topics were organized for the students. On behalf of this committee, minorities, backward classes, students who are lagging behind in studies, special needs students (disabled) were assisted from time to time.
- **D)** Social Justice and Empowerment Committee The Social Justice and Empowerment Committee has been set up in the college for the benefit of students belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Deprived Castes, Nomadic Tribes and Other Backward Classes. The committee has seven members and four members are student representatives. The principal is the chairman of the committee and the teacher's representative is Prof. Sukeshini Jogdand.

10. Employment Guidance Cell:

On behalf of this cell, students and alumni are provided guidance, counseling as well as campus interviews on the availability of job opportunities in various places. At the same time, students living in remote areas are given information about job advertisements by giving messages. The purpose of setting up the cell is to provide jobs to more and more college students.

11. Competition Exam Guidance Center:

Dr. Rama Pande is the Coordinator of the Employment Guidance Cell for the students. In the academic year 2020-2021, the MPSC class was started. A total 20 students have been admitted in the MPSC class. Rs. 1000 / - per month tuition fees charged.

17. Participation in various works/projects:

A) Assistance to flood victims in Ratnagiri district:

The river Vashishti near Chiplun town flowing through Ratnagiri district was flooded due to heavy rains in June and July 2021. Under the guidance of Mr. Aniket Lohia Karyawah, Manavlok, Dr. Hanumant Salanke Prof. Kisan Shingare, Mr. Ashok Kedar, Mr. Shamsudar Sarvade, Mr. Gajanan Potdar and activists of Manavlok. Abhijeet Kapase, Vithal Jamdar, Shri. Laxman Keskar, Shri. Parmeshwar Salunke, Shri. Deshmukh Ashok, Shri. They reached Chiplun town in Ratnagiri district for relief work. Immediate relief work was started after reviewing the situation there. The floods also washed away people's homes, roads and river. So the stench was gone. Also many animals were dead. In collaboration with Manavlok, blankets, sheets, bed sheets, women's and men's clothes, underwear, children's clothes, sanitizers, etc. were distributed to the flood affected families in 10 villages.

B) Participation in national programs:

Blood Donation Camp: Annual Blood Donation Camp is organized on the occasion of the anniversary of Marathwada Navnirman Lokayat (Manavlok). Like every year, blood donation camp was organized this year. Kovid-19 donated blood to 29 blood donors at Swami Ramanand Tirtha Medical College and Hospital Ambajogai.

18. Government of India Scholarship Scheme:

On behalf of Government of India, scholarships were given to backward class students as under: SC-23, NT-14, SBC-01, SEBC-03, OBC-06, Tribal Department-06. Benefited from the scheme.

19. Publication:

Manavlok Research Bulletin: The College has an independent publishing which publishes quarterly Manavlok Research Bulletin at every three months. This quarterly number 2349.3984 was regularly sent to 35 members from Maharashtra. Research articles are published in this quarter.

Gajar: The college publishes 'Gajar' twice a year with the aim of inculcating the habit of reading and inculcating writing skills for the overall development of the students. Students are given different subjects on behalf of the college. Out of this, the best writing was published in the special issue 'Gajar'.

20. Block Placement Training:

Block placement training is an essential part of social work study. For block placement training, Second year students are sent for one month to reputed NGOs in Maharashtra. The purpose is to provide students with the experience of NGO activities, donations to organizations, donor organizations as well as an organization with an experience of administrative work, students are appointed for a month to study. Due to the Corona Crisis, the students of the academic year were sent to a total of 15 reputed NGOs in Maharashtra as well as a total of 18 Government Institutions in compliance with all the rules and regulations for block placement.

On 30th August 2021, in the context of block placement training for students, Dr. An online workshop was conducted by Prakash Jadhav Coordinator. In this workshop 30 days issue wise information was given. These include organization registration system, organization objectives, history of work done by organization, work of voluntary organization office bearers, election system, budget, short and long term planning, events, administrative records, staff selection and training services, meeting planning, staff motivation, fund raising system, Detailed information was given about audit and documentation and report writing method. According to the above point, the student studied for one month and submitted the report to the college.
