About MANAVLOK

MANAVLOK stands for “MARathwada NAVnirman LOKayat”, where "Marathwada", geographically, is the central part of Maharashtra", "NAVNIIRMAN" means “Recreation” and 'LOKAYAT' denotes “for the people by the people”. Thus, it symbolizes recreating rural development for rural people with the support of rural people. MANAVLOK is a non-profit organization working for the betterment of less privileged people with a new idea or an experiment in integrated rural development, whereby villagers themselves are the focus of action and control. The organization is working in the sectors of Watershed Development Program, Krushak Panchayat, Disaster Relief Services, Manaswini Womens Project for Women Empowerment, Jansahayog, Social Work College, SHG's, Sanitation, Advocacy, and Monitoring & Evaluation of Government Programs as a holistic approach for integrated rural development.

In the early 1970s, a socialist group of youth began seeking solutions to social and political problems of the rural community with the general aim of achieving harmony in the society. After nearly 20 years of effort and agitations, they concluded that socio-political change was not possible without economic change. With this point of view, Dr. Dwarkadas Lohiya popularly known as “Babuji” laid down the foundation of MANAVLOK, a voluntary organization, in 1982 for the socio-economic upliftment of the rural poor.
